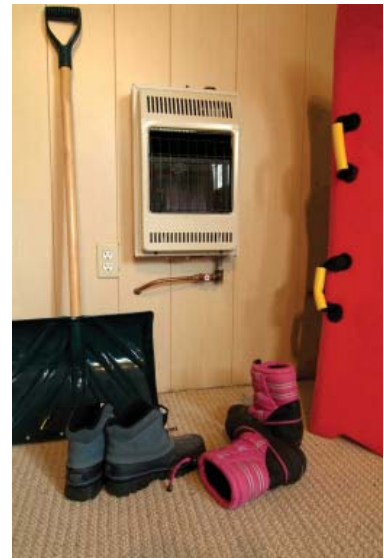


# Natural Gas Garage Heaters

A gravity vented garage heater vents naturally, without the assistance of a fan. A gravity vented unit uses the air in the garage for combustion. The warm by-products of combustion rise out of the garage heater through a flue pipe to the outdoors.
