



LIHEAP Helps.

If you need help paying your heating bills, the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), a federally funded program, may be a solution. Income guidelines have changed this year. **LIHEAP funding is limited, so applying early is critical.**

Gross Annual Income Guidelines:

| <u>Household Size</u> | <u>Maximum Income</u> |
|-----------------------|-----------------------|
| 1 | \$16,245 |
| 2 | \$21,855 |
| 3 | \$27,465 |
| 4 | \$33,075 |
| 5 | \$38,685 |
| 6 | \$44,295 |

To apply for LIHEAP, call or visit your local County Assistance Office. Be sure to apply in the county where you live. To apply, you will need the names, dates of birth, Social Security numbers, and proof of income for all members of the household, as well as a recent heating bill.

LIHEAP *Crisis grants* are available to eligible customers who have had their utility service shut off, or are facing shut off because of unpaid bills.

Please note: If you are applying for a Crisis Grant, you must have a shut-off notice. The Crisis grants will be available January 4, 2010.
